	We Christians glory in what Christ Jesus <u>has done</u> for us and realize that we are helpless to save ourselves.  Philippians 3:3d (LB)
	We couldn't carry this off by our own efforts, and we know it.
	Philippians 3:3d (Msg)
	THE TRAP:
	(Paul: Before I became a Christian, I was a legalist. I was trying to earn heaven through rituals, through my race, through religion, through rules and reputation. It wasn't working. If anyone was a legalist, I was.) As for legalistic righteousness, I was faultless.
	Paraphrase of Philippians 3:4-5; 6 (NIV)
2	EVERY DAY:
۷.	Those things that were <u>important</u> to me I now think they are <u>worth nothing</u> because of Christ.  Philippians 3:7 (NCV)
	THE TRAP: Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For
	his sake I have discarded everything else, <u>counting it all as garbage</u> , so that I could <u>gain Christ</u> <sup>9</sup> and <u>become</u> one <u>with him</u> .  Philippians 3:8-9a (NLT)
3.	EVERY DAY:
<b>.</b>	All I want is to know Christ and to experience the power of his resurrection, to share in his sufferings and become like him in his death, <sup>11</sup> in the hope that I myself will be raised from death to life.  Philippians 3:10-11(TEV)

	Be still, and know that I am God. Psalm 46:10 (NIV)
