

What does the word "covenant" mean?

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God." Revelation 21:3 (NIV)

Covenant = A Relationship with God that is based on God's promises and lived out in the midst of human community.

## What does scripture teach us about covenant?

## I. God's Promise to Abram

The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. I will make you into a great nation . . . and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you." Genesis 12:1–3 (NIV)

## 4. Josiah Reads the Book of the Covenant

The king stood by the pillar and renewed the covenant in the presence of the LORD—to follow the LORD and keep his commands, statutes and decrees with all his heart and all his soul, thus confirming the words of the covenant written in this book. Then all the people pledged themselves to the covenant. 2 Kings 23:3 (NIV)
