I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth;

- Everybody believes in something. Everyone has a creed they live by. What you believe shapes you and determines the way to understand the world and the people around you.

Today in the town of David a Savior has been born for you; he is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11 (NIV) Jesus came, conceived by the Holy Spirit, in order that He may come as ______. Jesus came, born through the Virgin Mary, in order that He may also be ______. 3. Suffered under Pontius Pilate . . . to ______. He took our suffering on him and felt our pain for us . . . But he was wounded for the wrong we did; he was crushed for the evil we did. The punishment, which made us well, was given to him, and we are healed because of his wounds. Isaiah 53:4-5 (NCV) 4. Crucified, dead and buried . . . Now God has made you his friends again. He did this through Christ's death in the body so that he might bring you into God's presence as people who are holy, with no wrong, and with nothing of which God can judge you guilty. Colossians I:22 (NCV) The biblical word for being made "acceptable to God" is It is ______ never sinned.
