1. KCPE EXAMINATION

Our 2018 candidates were well prepared for their National exams. All subjects' teachers ensured that they covered the syllabus early enough and started revision as early as July. The National examination (Kenya Certificate of Primary Education) is meant for all registered eighth grade students in the whole country. It took three days and one day for rehearsal.

- 29th October 2018—rehearsal
- 30th October 2018—Math, English, English Composition
- 31st October 2018—Science, Kiswahili, Insha
- 1st November 2018—Social Studies and Christian Religious Education

We sat for the KCPE at Sakwa Primary School but we shall receive our own results as Hope Educational Centre with code 43728281. Our results are expected to be out by end of November or early December 2018. I believe our candidates will do well.
